



LEED® Workshops 2008

CES #172 Introduction to LEED for New Construction (LEED NC) and LEED for Commercial Interiors (LEED CI)
 This day-long workshop will begin with an overview of sustainable and green design principles. The concept of Integrated Design and how it relates to the process, including the Green Design Charrette will be discussed. The US Green Building Council's (USGBC) LEED Rating Systems for both New Construction and Commercial Interiors will be reviewed in-depth, with appropriate US case study presentation and the potential applications in China and Asia markets. Design, Construction and Operation of buildings will be the focus of this session. Asia case studies will be presented.

CES #173 LEED AP Exam Preparation Workshop for both LEED NC and LEED CI
 Focusing on principals learned in the introductory session for LEED for New Construction and LEED for Commercial Interiors, this half-day class will assist in the preparation for the LEED AP (Accredited Professional) exam. With the LEED Reference Guide's review as a starting point, the other intricacies of the LEED rating system will be explored, including LEED Online, the Credit Interpretation Review (CIR) process, and other resources available to effectively prepare for the LEED Exam. A mock exam will be distributed to participants.
 (Prerequisite for attendance: Completed Introductory LEED NC/CI studies previously OR taking Sat workshop on LEED NC/CI organized by AIAHK.)

CES #174 LEED for Neighborhood Development (LEED ND) Workshop
 LEED for Neighborhood Development, currently in its pilot phase in the US, integrates green building and urbanism to create new neighborhood developments that employ smart growth techniques. By using existing infrastructure, previously developed sites and higher density planning, the neighborhoods' impact on the environment may be greatly reduced. This half-day session will focus on this new rating system and how its methods may help to encourage similar smart growth in China and Asia. Asia case studies will be presented.

Gunnar Hubbard is the Principal and founder of Fore Solutions, Consultants for High Performance Green Buildings. He is a Registered Architect, a LEED Accredited Professional and LEED Faculty member for the U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC). He is currently consulting on projects across the U.S. and in Europe including schools, large commercial buildings, retail and civic buildings. In addition to his project work, he leads workshops, seminars, and charrettes and teaches both the LEED CI and NC training courses nationwide for USGBC. Mr. Hubbard has also been involved in helping motivate regulatory reform around green buildings in the U.S.

Prior to founding Fore Solutions, Mr. Hubbard co-founded McCoppin Studios, an architectural firm based in San Francisco that specializes in environmentally responsible design. He also served as a Research Scholar in Green Development Services at the Rocky Mountain Institute and as the Executive Director of the Yestermorrow Design/Build School. He was a visiting professor at Ball State Universities, is a frequent speaker across the U.S. and a published writer in the area of green building. He received a Master in Architecture from the University of Oregon and a Bachelor of Science in Environmental Studies from the University of Vermont.
