On June 29, 2009, the AIA, along with the International Code Council (ICC) and ASTM International, announced the formation of the Sustainable Building Technology Committee (SBTC) and charged it with creating an International Green Construction Code (IGCC). The release of Public Version 1.0 of the IGCC, which is now available for public comment. While this milestone brings us one step closer to completion, we cannot realize this goal without your participation. To that end, the AIA has developed a web form where members can review and submit comments on Public Version 1.0 of the IGCC (and subsequent versions).
