

Raymond Wong is a well-established violinist and teacher in a career that spanned over 30 years.

He joined several prominent ensembles including the Hong Kong Philharmonic Orchestra as a first violin player in 1981 and recently a concert master. In the following year, Raymond Wong joined the Hong Kong Elite Chamber Orchestra on a tour to England, Israel and Cyprus. Additionally, he has also worked with the Queensland Philharmonic and the Queensland Symphony Orchestras, Australia in 1992.

He has shown exceptional talents not only to his craftsmanship of playing a violin in all manners of performances, but also his passion of teaching young and upcoming violinists to be more open and adaptable.

Raymond Wong has won several awards including the Hong Kong Commercial Radio Prize in a music competition in 1979. He also made appearances on RTHK's Hong Kong Concert Hall on several occasions.
