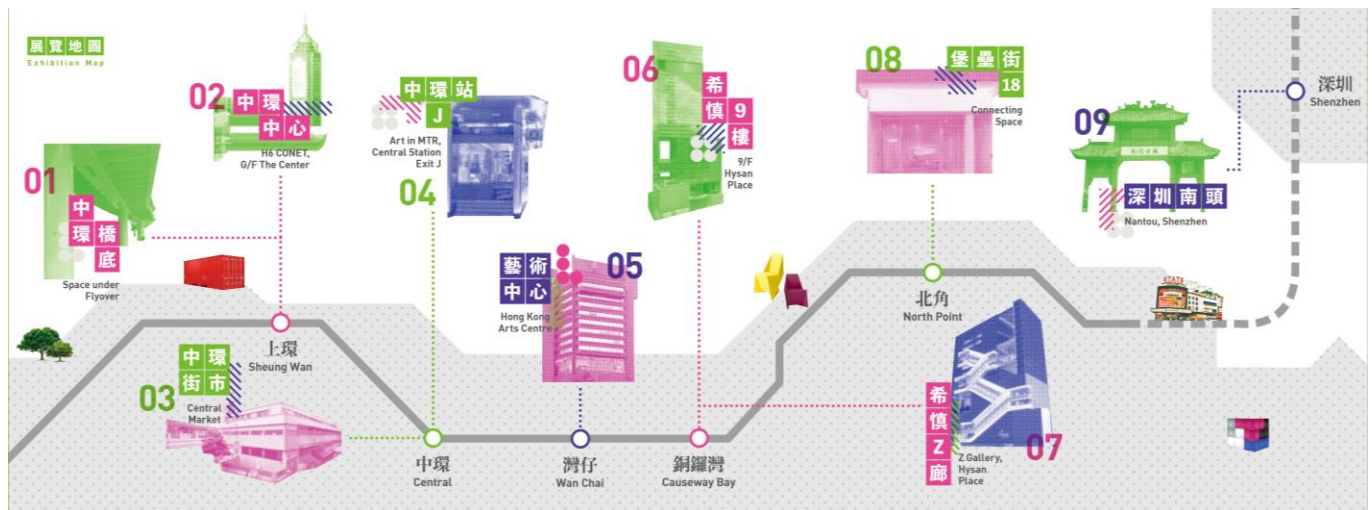


2017 Bi-City Biennale of Urbanism\Architecture (Hong Kong) Theme: 'City Smarts: Density 2.0'

As part of the missions of the Biennale, the Chief Curator Dr. Chan Lai-Kiu hopes to identify the core competency of Hong Kong and actions needed to continue the legend of Hong Kong in coming decades.

For this mission, a symposium on the theme of “Think Glocal (ie. Global and Local at the same time)” is co-organized by the Biennale Foundation, the Hong Kong Chapter of RIBA (Royal Institute of British Architects), the Hong Kong Chapter of AIA (the American Institute of Architects) and the Yangcheng Designers Association from Guangzhou. Hopefully, through the sharing of speakers and panelists from diverse disciplines and origins, we can identify the SWOT (Strength, Weakness, Opportunities and Threats) of Hong Kong, understand more the challenges we are facing, and find directions or actions that we can head for.
