Joint Venture / Associated Architects	Projects designed by joint venture or associated architects should be submitted by <b>ONE MEMBER ONLY</b> ; credit for all design participants must be noted in the Entry Form.		
Project Type	All entries that meet the requirements of their respective categories are eligible regardless of size, budget, style or building type.		
Previous Entries	Projects previously submitted to AIA Hong Kong Honors & Awards which did <b>NOT</b> win an award, <b>are eligible</b> for resubmission.		
Previous Awards	Projects previously honored with an award from AIA National, regional, state or local chapter components <b>are NOT eligible</b> for re-submission.		
Juror Ineligibility	Projects by architects and/or their design firms serving as jurors for the current year's award adjudication are <b>NOT</b> eligible for submission.		
Eligibility Right	The AIA Hong Kong Chapter reserves the right to determine the eligibility of all submissions.		

\*NOTE: The AIA Hong Kong Chapter's assigned territory includes Hong Kong SAR, China (excluding Shanghai), and the Asia-Pacific Region (excluding Japan).
